STATE PARK PASS @ MRL

The State Park Centennial Annual Pass Library Check-Out Program is a partnership between Indiana State Parks and the Indiana State Library. It's being done to commemorate Indiana's bicentennial.

MRL received one of 240 state parks passes that have been placed in circulation for check-out throughout Indiana. That means library users can get into 32 state parks and state forest recreation areas where entrance fees are charged. The pass is available at the Adult Circulation Desk and may be checked out for a week.

The Indiana State Library helped pay for the parks pass program. All public libraries in Indiana will receive at least one. State Parks officials say the goal is to provide access to parks for those who may never have visited.

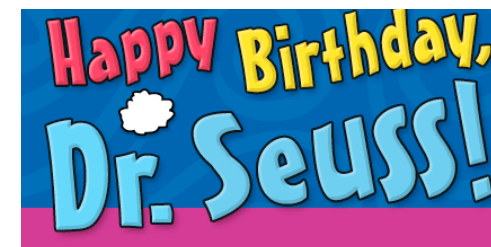
