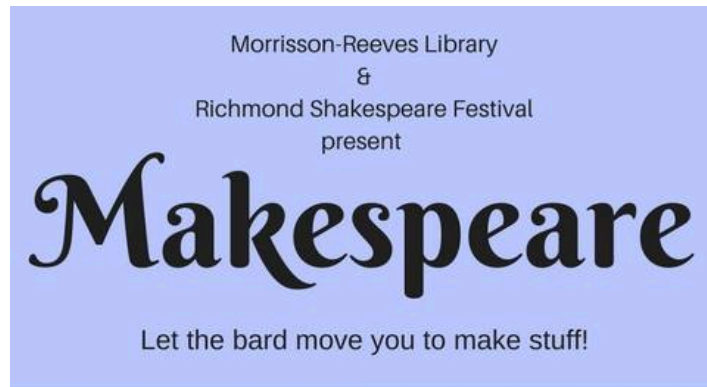

- The Prospero: Best Digital Media (digital art, photography, or video)
- The Bard: Best Execution of Shakespearean Theme (any media)

Prizes will be awarded for the winning pieces selected by a panel of local judges.
